CASTRIES CONSTITUENCY COUNCIL APPOINTS ITS FIRST CEO

Castries, March 3, 2017 – The Castries Constituency Council has appointed Miss Anselma Calderon as its first Chief Executive Officer (CEO) following a rigorous recruitment process. Miss Calderon has served as the Deputy Mayor from August 2, 2016.
